The season of Lent is drawing closer and closer. This year we all have a special opportunity to prepare for Easter through reading God's word. This year we have decided to partner with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship to read/listen to the New Testament during the forty days of Lent beginning on February 17. The Cooperative Baptist Fellowship has partnered with Faith Comes by Hearing to bring us "You've Got the Time: A Journey of Biblical Faithfulness." Each person will be given a CD with a dramatic reading of the New Testament on it. We are asking that each of you man, woman, teenager, and child join with us to commit to reading/listening to the New Testament for 30 minutes each day during Lent.
